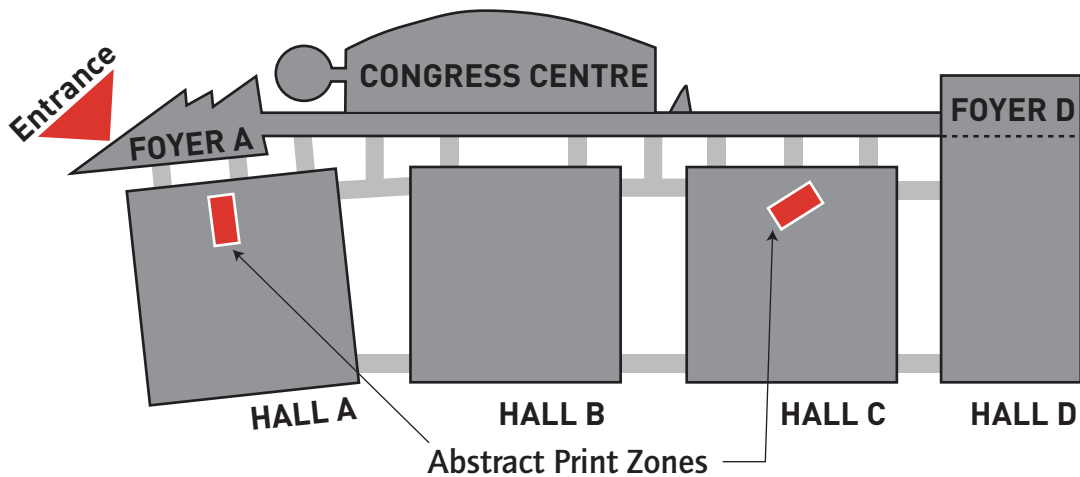

Your Personalised Abstract Book

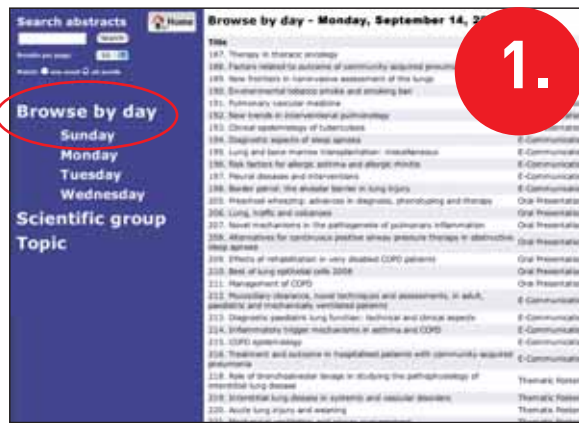
All abstracts are provided in electronic format only. The Abstract Print Zone gives participants free access to PCs in designated areas, allowing you to search for and print PDFs of relevant abstracts. Each PC is equipped with its own

printer, and staff are on hand to assist if necessary. Two Abstract Print Zones can be found at the Congress, in Halls A and C. Access to the electronic abstracts is made easy by the use of advanced search tools, which allow you to look up abstracts in four different ways:



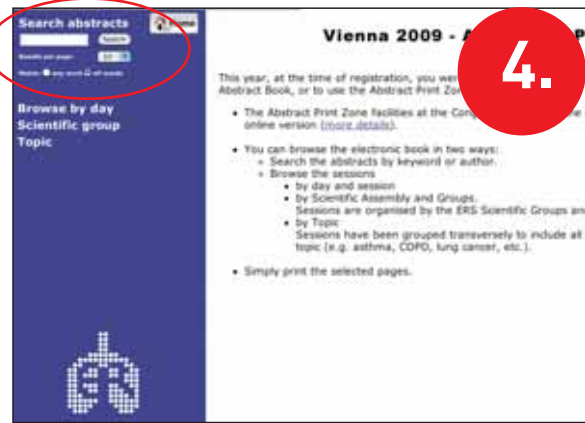
1. By day and session

If you have identified a Free Communication session you are interested in, you can select directly the day and session number (or title).



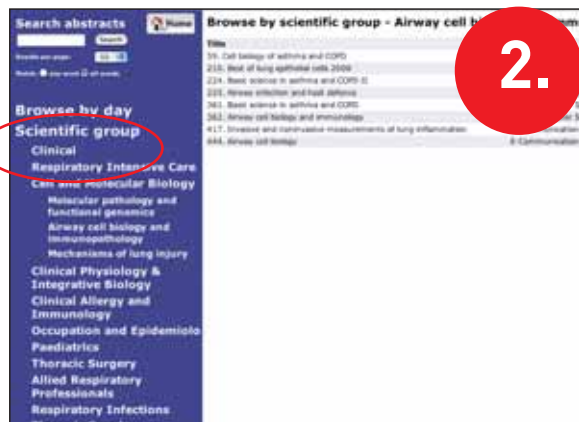
4. By keyword

If you are looking for abstracts on specific subjects, you can type in a word or a group of words to bring up all related abstracts.

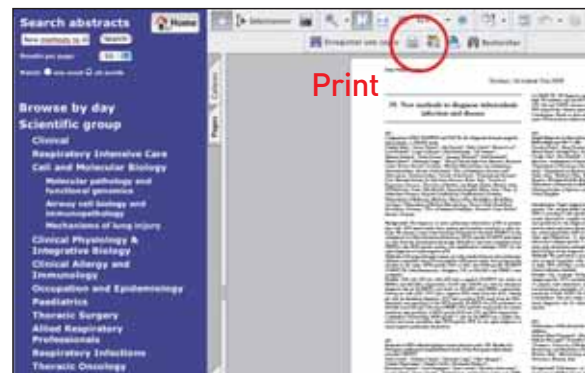


2. By Scientific Assembly or Group

Sessions are organised by the ERS Scientific Assemblies and Groups, enabling you to access abstracts from the Free Communication sessions organised by your preferred Group or Assembly.

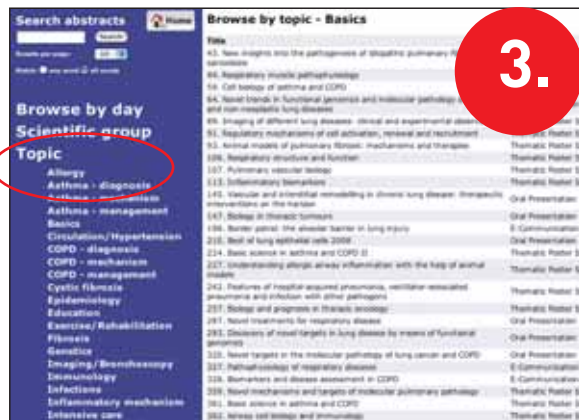


The pages of the *Abstract Book*, including all the abstracts in a particular session, will be displayed in PDF format, exactly as in an official publication. Simply print the selected pages. Each PC is equipped with its own printer for a quick and convenient self-service.



3. By topic

Sessions have been grouped thematically to include all those that may be related to a specific topic (e.g. asthma, COPD, lung cancer, etc.).



An Abstract Folder, which can be used to keep your abstract pages and notes in one place, is provided to all participants with the Congress bag.
