










Which Congress materials are you using the most following the event?





Yearly attendance to Congresses







3rd place



- Sustainability team onsite
- One panel with QR code referring to their Sustainability commitment
- Congress/exhibition briefing on sustainability before the conference, asking employees to switch off light in hotel bedrooms, share taxis to come to congress center, use train to travel overall vs plane, etc.







2nd place



With a base in Finland, they have exhibition sustainability in the center of what they do:

- Booth elements are reused at least 25 times (message from exhibitor and exhibition company)
- Total CO2 footprint of the exhibition: 10.1 tons which is compensated by the exhibition company, mainly with reforestation in Finland and in Brazil
- Booth set-up team: 4 pax who share trucks and come together, ie from truck driver to booth builder, maintenance and return or move to next congress





1st place



Differentiation to all other booths with overall sustainability commitment:

- Company plan in place including travel from employees
- Sustainability notification on booth elements
- TRACE plan to measure CO2 footprint for overall exhibition post event and action plan in place for "compensation"





Very professional appearance: lean booth concept, open, very easy accessible, seamless use of lightning to differentiate various product/disease areas, and between commercial and medical areas. Professionally manned booths with a counter for overall inquiries and with full sustainability company plan in place from the exhibition agency to the exhibitor
