











Construction heights



Construction height (please check also the transparency principle)

Heights are measured from the floor of the exhibition hall

1) **2,5m top edge:**

For side and back walls connecting to another stand directly on the **stand perimeter**.

- 2) 4,5m top edge inside the stand / min distance to edge is 0,5m:
- 3) **Suspended banners, cladded riggings: 4,5m top edge**Depth of hanging banners going around the stand space max. **1,2m**.
 Unbranded technical riggings for e.g. lighting may hang higher.

Construction heights



- 4) Any sight axis blocking elements higher 1,50m shall not block (also in combination with other elements of that height) more than 70% of the view from one side of a stand to the other (exemptions are separation or rear walls towards the neighbors that may be 2,50m high).
- 5) Open sides bordering to an aisle shall remain min. 70% unconstructed
- 6) Branding of surfaces facing neighbouring stands / Rear and side walls

Any kind of visible surface positioned close (<1,5m) to the neighbouring stand that could be perceived as part of the neighbour's stand shall not be branded.

(applicable for inline, corner, peninsular stands).


It is mandatory to erect or order rear and side walls. These walls must be completelly (from ground to top edge) closed, white, uncabled and clean on the sides facing neighbors.

Best designed stand - with sustainable goals





- MSD presented a coherently structured and sustainability-driven booth. Composed of 3
 interconnected zones, the stand balanced medical, pipeline and brand-focused areas, each with it's
 own narrative yet unified under a consistent design identity.
- Each area served a clear function: the product and medical corners offered focused scientific interactions, while a dedicated "reflection area" with a distinctive red chair invited healthcare professionals to pause and consider how they could further improve patient outcomes, a subtle but thoughtful engagement concept.
- The real strength of the MSD booth, however, lay in it's booth builder's sustainability leadership. The construction partner, certified by "Better stands" and operating with net-zero carbon objectives, demonstrated exceptional commitment to circular objectives.

Best designed stand - with sustainable goals





- GSK presented a well-structured yet slightly complex booth, balancing medical and commercial areas through clear color and dress-code differentiation, orange attire for the medical team and white for the commercial staff, with language badges adding a practical touch for international visitors.
- Sustainability was visible mainly through operational choices rather than booth design:
 - GSK has reduced travel and delegate sponsorships (from 900 two years ago to around 350 this year). Delegates were asked to leverage the local transportation passe included in the congress registration.
 - The booth manning team was partially international but also local and where feasible, GSK staff travelled by train to Amsterdam (UK based team)
 - The hotel used for booth building team and selected member is powered by renewable electricity and they
 ensured many staff stayed within walking distance of the venue.
 - These measures, while maybe also partly budget-driven, reflected a tangible commitment to lower environmental impact.




- The Sanofi Regeneron booth had a wide, open lounge area centered on a large LED screen and welcome counter designed to engage while informing the visitors.
- The booth retained the AR experience in nasal polyps, which added interactivity.
- Overall, the organisation of the stand felt more mature than 2024, with improved technology integration and clearer spatial logic.






- AstraZeneca took another clear step forward in integrating sustainability into its booth concept compared with 2024. Once again, a dedicated sustainability corner/full path was incorporated, standing out as a genuine differentiator among exhibitors.
- Design-wise, the booth also used thin, colored paper drape-fascia to delineate spaces while maintaining an airy and professional atmosphere. This itself is also made of "drop paper" item, which at the end of life is repurposed in the infinitely recyclable "drop cake".
- Even small details reinforced the overall impression of thoughtful design and organization, and the dress code was adapted by role:
 - Medical booth staff wore coordinated scarves and ties.
 - Commercial teams opted for elegantly branded vests, keeping a consistent yet differentiated look and something new vs usual poloshirts, scarfs, ties.


